Bill No. 7862 - A Bill to repeal Ordinance No. 2997, passed by Council August 16, 1982, which created a 30 minute parking zone on the south side of Franklin Avenue from a point 32 feet west of the intersection of Franklin Avenue and Greenbrier Street to a point 69 Feet west of the intersection of Franklin Avenue and Greenbrier Street during the hours from 7:00 AM to 5:00 PM, Monday through Friday and amending the Traffic Control Map and Traffic Control File, established by the code of the City of Charleston, West Virginia, two thousand and three, as amended, Traffic Laws, Section 263, Division 2, Article 4, Chapter 114, to conform therewith.

Bill No. 7863 amending the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Charleston, West Virginia, enacted the 1st day of January 2006, as amended, and the map made a part thereof, by creating the Neighborhood Reinvestment Overlay Zoning District including provisions for residential density, parking, and development standards, containing all parcels of land as shown on the attached map included as Exhibit A, Charleston, West Virginia.
