Price was due to: a.) an unforeseen condition (water line not shown on plans) that required the discharge piping leaving the valve vault to be reconfigured and b.) installation of segmental block retaining wall to better accommodate sloped ground adjacent to a sidewalk. The increase in Contract Time was due to COVID 19 related delays.

Consider for approval, and authorize the General Manager, or his designee, to effect the award of a purchase contract to Premier Magnesia, LLC of Waynesville, NC, the only responsible bidder, for magnesium hydroxide slurry to be used for odor control at three pump station sites at \$2.92/gal., with an estimated need of 31,300 gallons for a total estimated cost of \$91,369.00.
