Bill No. 7957 - A Bill to repeal ordinance 7908, passed by Council on May 3, 2021, which established a one-way street on 2nd Avenue from Florida Street to Bream Street by prohibiting vehicular traffic from traveling in an easterly direction, and re-establishing this portion of 2nd Avenue as a two-way street; and modifying existing and/or adding necessary traffic control devices and amending the Traffic Control Map and Traffic Control File, established by the code of the City of Charleston, West Virginia, two thousand and three, as amended, Traffic Laws, Section 263, Division 2, Article 4, Chapter 114, to conform therewith.

Bill No. 7821, Committee Substitute - A BILL to amend and reenact Section 114-402 of the Code of the City of Charleston, as amended; and to amend said Code by adding thereto a new Article, designated Article XV, consisting of Section 114-940, all relating to safely traveling the streets of Charleston; reducing; and authorizing the use of low-speed vehicles consistent with state law.

3. New Business

Bill No. 7956 - A BILL to amend and reenact Sections 114-915, 114-916, 114-917, 114-918, and 114-920 of the Municipal Code of the City of Charleston, as amended, all relating to authorizing the use of motorized scooters; updating definitions; requiring operators of motorized scooters to follow traffic laws; setting certain additional requirements for operating a motorized scooter after sunset and before sunrise; detailing additional prohibited acts; and creating criminal penalties for violations.

Bill No. 7965 - A Bill to establish a no parking zone on the west side of Dunbar Street, Wednesdays 6:00 am through 10:00am located from a point 189 feet north of Quarrier Street to a point 245 feet north of Quarrier Street and amending the Traffic Control Map and Traffic Control File, established by the code of the City of Charleston, West Virginia, two thousand and three, as amended, Traffic Laws, Section 263, Division 2, Article 4, Chapter 114, to conform therewith.
