Bill No. 7963, Committee Substitute - A Bill amending the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Charleston, West Virginia, enacted the 1st day of January 2006, as amended, and the map made a part thereof, by rezoning from a R-4 district to a C-10 district, portions of Lots 5 and 6 of Block 37 located at 501 Patrick Street in the City of Charleston, Kanawha County, State of West Virginia, owned by C W PROPERTIES LLC and petitioned for by Mitch Rashid.

Bill No. 7969 - A Bill amending the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Charleston, West Virginia, enacted the 1st day of January 2006, as amended, and the map made a part thereof, by rezoning from a R-4 district to a R-O district, that certain lot or parcel of land located at 280 Oakwood Road in the City of Charleston, Kanawha County, State of West Virginia, owned by Will Robinson and Benjamin Embrey.

Bill No. 7970 - A Bill to establish a handicapped parking zone on Northerly side of Central Avenue from a point 110 feet west of Elm Street to a point 132 feet west of Elm Street and amending the Traffic Control Map and Traffic Control File, established by the code of the City of Charleston, West Virginia, two thousand and three, as amended, Traffic Laws, Section 263, Division 2, Article 4, Chapter 114, to conform therewith.

Bill No. 7972 - A Bill to establish a no parking zone on the north side of Ravinia Road located from a point 50 feet west of Zel Road to a point 120 feet west of Zel Road along an area where a guard rail currently is in place and amending the Traffic Control Map and Traffic Control File, established by the code of the City of Charleston, West Virginia, two thousand and three, as amended, Traffic Laws, Section 263, Division 2, Article 4, Chapter 114, to conform therewith.
