Chair Keeley Steele called the meeting to order at 3:00 p.m. Without a quorum present, approval of the minutes of the May 5, 2022 meeting were deferred to the next meeting, as was discussion of the Public Art Plan.

Director Jeff Pierson provided an overview and update of projects in process. He noted that private funds for the Coliseum steps have been identified and an RFQ will be developed. Plans for Festival and Regatta art projects were briefly discussed.

The City is storing the sculpture which formerly resided in front of the KCPL. Jeff Pierson will discuss possible locations for the sculpture with the KCPL.

To educate commission members, Lori Brannon presented a review of how the City regulates signage and murals. The focus is on time, place, and manner. A mural permitting program is a way to control the aesthetic of the installation and may be further refined. Zoning ordinances regarding signage and murals may need to be addressed due to a 2015 U.S. Supreme Court decision in Reed vs. Town of Gilbert. More to follow on that.
